Our Father, . . . Hail Mary . . .

O Jesus, Holy Mary, St. Ann, help me now and at the hour of my death.

Good St. Ann, intercede for me.

FIRST DAY

Dear St. Ann, though I am but a prodigal child, I appeal to you and place myself under your great motherly care. Please listen to my prayers and grant my requests. See my contrite heart, and show me your unfailing goodness.

Deign to be my advocate and recommend me to God's infinite mercy. Obtain for me forgiveness of my sins and the strength to begin a new life that will last forever.

Blessed St. Ann, I also beg of you the grace to love, to serve, and to honor your daughter, the most holy Virgin Mary. Please recommend me to her and pray to her for me. She refuses none your requests but welcomes with loving kindness all those for whom you intercede.

Good Jesus, be merciful to the faithful servants of Your grandmother St. Ann.

SECOND DAY

From the depths of my heart, good St. Ann, I offer you my homage this day and ask you to shelter me under the mantle of your motherly care. You know, good mother, how much I love you, how gladly I serve you, how happy I am to praise you, how eager I am to call on you in time of distress.

Good St. Ann, be pleased to extend your helping hand in all my wants. Listen to my prayers, for I place my trust in your gracious bounty. Make all my thoughts and desires worthy and righteous.

Jesus, I thank You for all the graces which in Your infinite goodness You have lavished upon St. Ann; for having chosen her, among all women, to be Your grandmother on earth and exalted her in heaven with such great and miraculous powers. In the name of her merits, I humbly recommend myself to Your infinite mercy.

THIRD DAY

Hail, good St. Ann, who first responded to the needs of Mary, Mother of our Savior and Queen of Angels. Hail to you and to your husband St. Joachim, who watched over her infancy, presented her to the Lord in the temple and, according to your promise, consecrated her to the service of God.

Good St. Ann, by the great power that God has given you, show yourself my mother, my consoler, my advocate. Reconcile me to the God I have so deeply offended. FIFTH DAY

Hail, all-powerful Lady. By God's special favor, grant consolation to those who invoke you. Procure for them the eternal riches of heaven, and like a good mother, success in their temporal affairs as well.

Good St. Ann, obtain my deliverance from the punishment which my sins deserve. Obtain for me success in my temporal affairs; especially see to the salvation of my soul.

St. Ann, by your influence with Mary's son Jesus, you have won the gift of conversion for many sinners. Will you then abandon me, who have chosen you as my mother? No, St. Ann. Your name alone, which signifies grace, assures me of the help of your prayers, and these prayers will surely procure pardon and mercy from Jesus. You will pray for me now and at the hour of my death.

SIX DAY

Good St. Ann, do not allow my soul, a masterpiece of God's creative power, to be lost forever. Free my heart of pride, vanity, self-love. May I know myself as I really am and learn meekness and simplicity of heart.

God's great love for me leaves me cold and unresponsive. I must reflect this love through works of mercy and charity toward my neighbor.

In your boundless charity, good St. Ann, help me to merit the glorious crown which is given to those who have fought the good fight against the world, the devil and the flesh. Assist me to preserve purity of heart and body. With Mary and her divine Son, protect me always.

SEVENTH DAY

Keynote Speaker Patrick Madrid



Patrick is the publisher and author of twelve books on Catholic themes including, *Pope Fiction*, *Search and Rescue*, *Does the Bible Really Say That?* and *150 Bible Verses Every Catholic Should Know*.

Active in apologetics since 1987, he served as vice president of Catholic Answers for eight years (1988 through 1995) and helped co-found that apostolate's flagship magazine, *This Rock*, in January of 1990. He is the host of four EWTN television series, including "Pope Fiction" and "Search & Rescue," and he hosts the Thursday edition of EWTN Radio's "Open Line".

Patrick is the publisher of *Envoy Magazine*, a journal of contemporary Catholic thought, and he is director of the Envoy Institute of Belmont Abbey College. Since its inception in 1996, the *Envoy* team has garnered numerous journalism awards, including several first-place awards in the magazine-of-the-year "General Excellence" category from the Catholic Press Association.

He edited and co-authored the acclaimed multi-volume *Surprised by Truth* series (with over 400,000 combined copies in print in English and Spanish), and he has published numerous popular articles on Scripture, Church history, patristics, apologetics, and evangelization in various Catholic periodicals.

Patrick earned a bachelor of science degree in business from the University of Phoenix and a bachelor of philosophy degree (B.Phil.) from the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio, where he is completing a master's degree in theology. He has also done graduate studies in theology at the University of Dallas.

Patrick serves on the board of trustees of the Dominican School of Philosophy and Theology in Berkeley, CA, and on the board of directors of St. Gabriel Catholic Radio, in Columbus, OH. In 2007, he authored all the original website content for CatholicsComeHome.org, where he also serves as a theological advisor. He was a founding board member of the Catholic Marketing Network.

Patrick is a cradle-Catholic, not a convert. By God's grace, he was raised in the Catholic Faith and has been a practicing Catholic his entire life. Patrick and his wife Nancy have been married for 27 years and have been blessed with eleven healthy and happy children and five grandchildren (who are also happy and healthy).

Fr. William Carroll

Fr. Carroll is Parochial Vicar at St. Mary of the Annunciation Parish in Melrose. He is also the Director of Marian Societies for the Archdiocese of Boston.

James Drummey

Jim is a nationally known writer and speaker on matters involving the Catholic Church. He has been involved in the religious education of children and adults for more than three decades and is co-author and publisher of the popular five-volume Catholicism Series (www.cpublications.com), which is being used in hundreds of Catholic high schools and parishes throughout the country. As editor for the past 15 years of a weekly newspaper column entitled "Catholic Replies," Mr. Drummey has answered thousands of questions about religion. He has published 1,600 of his answers in two books, *Catholic Replies* and *Catholic Replies 2*. A native of Massachusetts, Mr. Drummey and his wife, Terry, are the parents of 10 children and grandparents of nine.

Frank Kelly

He was raised the sixth of twelve children in a devout Irish Catholic family in Boston. In 1985, he miraculously survived what should have been a lethal dose of electricity. Frank's life then took a dramatic turn and his early devotion to the sacraments, rosary and prayer expanded and increased. Now he travels throughout the country, sharing his life changing experience and story, which is the subject of the book "Short Circuit to God." He has been blessed with many apostolic gifts. Frank's ministry, which is faithful to the Magisterium, consists of: Healing Services, Spiritual Seminars, Confirmation instruction Classes, Retreats and Conferences. His periods of prayer with individuals are powerfully accentuated by his gifts of discerning word of knowledge and healing- often accompanied by scriptural verses personally designated for the recipient of his prayers to the Lord. Many have been touched by God, through this simple, humble man, whom God uses as a vessel to heal mind, body and soul.

Dr. Mary Martin

Dr. Martin is a board certified obstetrician-gynecologist working in Oklahoma. After a life-changing experience in confession, she stopped prescribing all contraceptives. She now uses the Billings Method of NFP daily to diagnosis and treat patients. She is on the Board of Directors for the Billings Ovulation Method for the U.S. and speaks frequently on a national and international level about the effectiveness and benefits of NFP.

Fr. Daniel McCaffrey

Fr. McCaffrey was ordained in 1958 and spent over eight years as a missionary in Pakistan. He holds a Doctorate in Sacred Theology from the University of St. Thomas Aquinas (Angelicum) in Rome. Father served more than 20 years in active duty with the US Army Chaplain Corps in Vietnam, Korea, Germany, Honduras and throughout the U.S. He currently works in full-time ministry spreading the Church's Teaching on human sexuality at both the parish and diocesan levels.
